What three names have been used throughout history for the natural spring found in the park?

LINCOLN BOYHOOD HOME- Hodgenville

What was the name of Lincoln's young friend that saved his life one day while crossing Knob Creek?

LINCOLN MUSEUM AND DOWNTOWN STATUES- Hodgenville

What was the city of Hodgenville called when Lincoln was born in 1809?

KENTUCKY HISTORICAL SOCIETY- Frankfort

Which two native Kentuckians are featured in portraits above Lincoln's pocket watch?

STATE CAPITOL ROTUNDA- Frankfort

Who is the other "president" memorialized with a statue in the rotunda?

ASHLAND: THE HENRY CLAY ESTATE- Lexington

Ashland has a reproduction of a painting of Abraham Lincoln at the one event at which he likely met Henry Clay. What is the event?

MARY TODD LINCOLN HOUSE- Lexington

The museum's collection includes a silver mug given to the Lincoln's youngest son, Tad. What occasion does it commemorate?

CAMP NELSON CIVIL WAR HERITAGE PARK- Nicholasville

How many rooms are located in the White House at Camp Nelson?

FARMINGTON HISTORIC PLANTATION- Louisville

How old was Abraham Lincoln when he visited Farmington?

LINCOLN MEMORIAL AT WATERFRONT PARK- Louisville

What kind of book is Lincoln holding in his hand as he looks out over the Ohio River?

WHITE HALL STATE HISTORIC SITE- Richmond

The signed Lincoln document at White Hall is dated what year?

LINCOLN LEGACY MUSEUM- Springfield

What was Thomas Lincoln's property tax in Washington County in 1801?

ABRAHAM LINCOLN LIBRARY AND MUSEUM- Near Middlesboro

What personal item was left in the Presidential Box at Ford's Theatre the night President Abraham Lincoln was assassinated by John Wilkes Booth?

PERRYVILLE STATE HISTORIC SITE- Perryville

At the location where a young Lieutenant fought to hold his position during the battle of Perryville, there is now a reproduction cannon named after a famous European leader. What is the name of the cannon?

HARDIN COUNTY HISTORY MUSEUM- Elizabethtown

What young niece of Abraham Lincoln visited the White House during the Civil War and insisted that Jefferson Davis was the real president?

CENTRE COLLEGE LINCOLN STATUE- Danville

Which Centre College alumnus loaned Lincoln his first law books and eventually became his first law partner?

JEFFERSON DAVIS BIRTHPLACE STATE HISTORIC SITE- Fairview

A Confederate States of America Medal of Honor was issued on October 13, 1862. Who was the recipient?

LINCOLN HOMESTEAD STATE PARK- Springfield

Located near the historic cabins is a stone memorial. Who does the memorial honor?

CIVIL WAR MUSEUM OF THE WESTERN THEATRE- Bardstown

What was the famous Union artillery battery from New Orleans that fought at the battle of Perryville?
